- Have at least two enthusiastic teachers and/or media specialists who will collaborate together and with the Teen Author Assembly Committee, serve as school leaders, and meet all program commitments.
- Commitments include:
 - Prepare a group of up to 70 students to attend the assembly.
 - Schedule time for reading and discussions.
 - Prepare the other adults at your school who will attend the assembly with students.
 - Coordinate transportation for your students to the assembly. Multnomah County Library will reimburse your costs up to \$200.
 - Complete the evaluation forms within two weeks following the lecture.

Multnomah County Library agrees to provide participating schools with transportation to the assembly, booktalks, books for students, discussion guides and author information.
